### **CLASSROOM FEES**

**All K-6th Grade Students – Art Fee (Due November 1st):**

Each K – 6<sup>th</sup> student is assessed a fee of \$30 for classroom arts/crafts resources.

**3rd-6th Science Fee (Due December 1st):** The 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade class has a \$30 science fee to purchase materials for the student's participation in science projects that replace the Science Fair.

### **STUDENT SUPPLIES**

**All K-8th Grade Students:** Students in K-8th grade may drink water in their classroom – and on warm days this is important. However, they may only have water in ***water bottles with the snap close top to prevent damage to textbooks and devices in case of spillage. Each student should bring a water bottle with their name written on it with permanent marker or label.*** Because FCS no longer has drinking fountains, but rather water stations to ensure sanitation, it is vital that students bring their water bottle each day – otherwise, students will be sent to the office to purchase a water bottle.

**All K-8th Grade Students - Incentives Fee (Due October 1st):**

Each K-8th Grade teacher maintains an incentives program – prizes rewarding achievement. Each student in these grades is assessed a \$30 fee to cover the costs of this program.

**All K-6th Grade Students:** All K-6th grade students will be required to purchase a field trip “t-shirt” before going on a field trip with their class. These shirts will help us keep track of all our precious children whenever the class takes a field trip. T-shirts will cost \$25.00 each. After purchasing the t-shirt, please write your student's name on the inside tag with a permanent marker. Students will not be permitted to go on a field trip without this t-shirt.

**All 1st-8th Grade Students:** Students in 1st-8th grade will need a Chromebook device.
